MAMMOGRAPHY SERVICES TO MOVE AT HALIFAX REGIONAL

New Location Opens November 2

ROANOKE RAPIDS, NC (October 30, 2009)—Halifax Regional moves its mammography service to a new location Monday to increase convenience for patients and physicians.

The Mammography Center will be located in Suite E, Halifax Medical Plaza, formerly called the Annex, at 210 Smith Church Road.

The mammography service adjoins the MRI Center, which is in Suite D of the Plaza. The two imaging services will share a reception area.

Any woman with an appointment for a mammogram beginning Monday, November 2, should report to the new location. Signage directs patients to the new location. For more information, visit www.halifaxregional.us.

Halifax Regional's mammography service is approved by both the Federal and State governments, demonstrating that patient care is excellent. Inspectors have evaluated the entire mammogram service, including radiation protection, qualifications of the staff, equipment, and patient reports.
