ROANOKE RAPIDS, NC (October 14, 2010)—Roanoke and Wildwood Clinics are now in-network for subscribers to Aetna and United Healthcare.

“We are pleased to be a part of these coverage plans,” said Mary Pat Whaley, practice administrator at Halifax Regional. “We joined these networks because of requests from residents in the area who wanted to use Roanoke and Wildwood Clinics.

“By being in-network, Roanoke and Wildwood Clinics will be accessible and affordable to subscribers of Aetna and United Healthcare,” Whaley added.

Roanoke and Wildwood Clinics offer medical services for the entire family, including minor emergencies and lab services. Roanoke Clinic is located on the campus of Halifax Regional, and Wildwood Clinic is located at Lake Gaston on River Road.

The Clinics are also in-network for other insurance carriers, including Blue Cross Blue Shield, Cigna, Cigna Medicare, Coventry/Great West, Humana Gold, MedCost, Carolina Access, Tricare and Unicare. They also accept patients with Medicare and NC Medicaid.

“In addition, our Clinics also have several affordable plans for individuals who do not have insurance,” said Whaley. Those individuals should call the Physician Billing Office at (252) 535-8862 for more information.

Whaley encourages everyone to select a primary care provider. “The best way to gain access to healthcare services is to have a personal provider,” she said. “Your provider manages your care and ensures you receive the services you need, regardless of when you have health issues.”
