### **HALIFAX REGIONAL TO MOVE WOUND CARE CENTER**

**ROANOKE RAPIDS, NC (August 12, 2010)—Halifax Regional’s Wound Care Center is moving to a larger location Wednesday.**

Opened only six months ago, the Wound Care Center has outgrown its current space at 120 Professional Drive in Roanoke Rapids. “The response in the community to this new service has been greater than we anticipated,” said Mick Olesnevich, RN, manager of special services at Halifax Regional.

The new location is in Halifax Medical Park in Building C. To reach the Wound Care Center, patients turn left off Smith Church Road onto the road leading to the Emergency Care Center. Take the second left, and the Wound Care Center is the last building on the street. The official address is 244-C Smith Church road.

The location in the Halifax Medical Park will have more space and more exam rooms so patients will be treated promptly. “This new space will have an excellent environment for our patients,” Olesnevich said.

In addition, this new location has more parking, which is in front of the building.

“Overall, patients will find this a convenient location and appreciate the additional space and a favorable climate for treating their wounds,” said Olesnevich. “I believe the outcome will be improved times for healing;”
