Nathaniel Ausby retired after 45 years of service. The staff thanked him for his outstanding service at a reception.

"Today, it is most unusual to have employees work at one place for their entire career," said Will Mahone, president. "Nathaniel has been part of the fabric of the Medical Center for so long. He has made a difference at the Medial Center, and we will miss him."

Ausby is Assistant Director of Plant Operations, overseeing the daily functions of maintaining the building.

In retirement, Ausby will continue as Chief of the Fire Department in Garysburg, volunteer in his church and work on landscaping and cars.

He refers to his wife, Lola, as "my jewel." They have four grandchildren, and he'll have more time to spend with them.
