FREE BREAST EXAM CLINIC OCTOBER 6TH Local Health Groups Collaborate During Breast Cancer Awareness Month to Promote Early Detection

ROANOKE RAPIDS, NC (October 2, 2012)—Halifax Regional, Rural Health Group, and Roanoke Valley Breast Cancer Coalition are partnering together on Saturday, October 6th to host a Free Breast Exam Clinic to provide screening, education, information, and resources to women of Halifax and Northampton Counties. The breast exam clinic will be held Saturday, October 6, 2012 from 9:00 a.m.-noon at Roanoke Clinic located at 1385 Medical Center Drive on the medical campus of Halifax Regional.

Physicians and nurse practitioners will donate their time to perform the free breast exams. Digital mammograms also will be available. Healthcare professionals will be on site to educate women about proper breast care, breast self-exams and the importance of early detection as the best protection against breast cancer.

"Breast exams and screening are vital to early detection of breast cancer. This event is focused on bringing breast screening and breast health education to medically underserved populations within the Roanoke Valley," said Audrey Hardy, MSN, RN, manager of Medical Surgical Nursing at Halifax Regional and event organizer.

"Our purpose is to provide awareness, information, resources and increased access to breast care for the women of the Roanoke Valley," Hardy added. Our aim is to create a pink print across the Roanoke Valley for breast care. Transportation
